

Professor Heidi Andrade and Dr. Susan M. Brookhart visited our school on 26<sup>th</sup> Jan. 2011 to address the teachers and throw light on role of Formative and Summative Assessment. They shared with our teachers, the role of formative assessment in student motivation and achievement, the connection between classroom assessment and large scale assessment, and grading.

Professor Heidi Andrade, Ed.D, is an Associate professor of education psychology and associate Dean for Academic affairs at the School of Education, University at Albany-State University of New York and received her Masters and doctoral from Harvard Graduate School of Education. Her research and teaching focus on the relationships between thinking, learning and assessment, with emphasis on performance assessment, student self assessment and self –regulated learning. She has written numerous articles, including award winning article on rubrics for Educational Leadership (1997).

Dr. Susan M. Brookhart is an independent educational consultant and author based in Helena , Montana. She received her Ph.D. in Educational Research and Evaluation from Ohio State University in 1989. She has been the Education columnist for national Forum, the journal of Phi Kappa Phi. She is an author and co-author of eleven books and 50 articles on classroom assessment, teacher professional development and evaluation. She currently serves as a Senior Research Associate in the Center for Advancing the Study of Teaching and Learning in the School of Education at Duquesne.
